

Camp Travel Procedures

1. An ideal way for attendee's to travel to Camp RYLA is for the sponsoring Rotary club to provide transportation. There should be at least two adults or at least two passengers in the vehicle. This gives Rotarians the opportunity to get to know the students and to discuss Camp RYLA. During the return trip from Camp RYLA, Rotarians and attendees will have the opportunity to discuss the aspects of Camp RYLA and how the experience is and will impact their lives.

2. Parents can take the attendees to Camp RYLA and pick them up. Attendees must be at Camp RYLA between 3:00 PM and 5:30 PM on February 22nd and cannot leave until noon on February 26. Attendees cannot leave Camp RYLA without their parents' permission.

Attendee cannot leave and then return to Camp RYLA for any reason other than an emergency. Exceptions are extremely rare and only with the permission of the Camp RYLA Committee Chair.

3. An attendee may drive to Camp RYLA. Upon arrival, keys will be turned over to the Camp RYLA Committee and under no circumstance can an attendee return to their car without a Rotarian accompanying them.

We must have a copy of the Automobile Insurance Coverage for our files.

Without proof of insurance one cannot park their vehicle on Florida Elks Youth Camp property. It will be subject to towing.
