

The suggested questions below are provided to assist Rotarians with interviewing students that have applied for a Camp RYLA Scholarship. These questions are designed to stimulate student responses that will enable you to select the best candidates.

In addition to or in lieu of the questions below, use other questions you feel are appropriate to get the best results from each interview.

Camp RYLA Sample Interview Questions

- 1. How would you describe yourself?
- 2. Name one thing that you have done that made you feel good about yourself.
- 3. How do you feel one's characteristics defines leadership?
- 4. What makes a good leader?
- 5. Either living or dead, who has proven to be a good leader and why?
- 6. Give an example of a good leader and why?
- 7. Have you ever been in a leadership role? When? How? Result? (refer to applicants written essay)
- 8. Would you accept a leadership role in school if offered?
- 9. Tell us about your school and community activities.
- 10. Tell us about your school grades. What are your best subjects?
- 11. If you could change something about your school or community, what would it be? How would you go about making the change?
- 12. What are some of your short term and long term goals?
- 13. What do you know about Rotary?
- 14. What do you know about Camp RYLA?
- 15. Why are you applying to attend Camp RYLA? Be specific.
- 16. Is there anything you would like to share with us that would give us a reason to select you for Camp RYLA instead of another student?
- 17. Once a student arrives at Camp RYLA they cannot leave to attend another event. Do you foresee any conflicts with attending Camp RYLA February 22 26, 2017?
- 18. Would you be willing to be an alternate if not chosen to be a primary attendee?
- 19. Do you have any questions about Camp RYLA we can answer for you?
